Each module teaches a collaborative, multi-disciplinary approach and provides a consistent set of protocols, practical checklists, decision points, and suggested communication to use during early critical patient management.

Learning Objectives

1. Recognize the signs and symptoms of the neurological emergency
 2. Perform a focused neurological examination and calculate the Glasgow Coma Scale (GCS) score
 3. Rapidly implement the recommended management protocol
